ACCESS FOR MINORS

The Patterson Library will not restrict access to library services, materials, and/or facilities based on the age of the library users. As stated in the Patron Code of Conduct policy section, all children under the age of 10 must be accompanied at all times by a parent /caregiver, 18 years or older, while on library premises. As the ALA states, we too stand by the doctrine, “that parents—and only parents—have the right and the responsibility to restrict the access of their children—and only their children—to library resources.” The Patterson Library will not assume a parental or guardianship role for any minor using the library or any of its provided services.

All people, regardless of age, possess the First Amendment rights, including the right to information and it is our obligation to uphold these rights. We will not limit anyone of any age from any information they may be seeking through our services and will strive to provide unrestricted use of all the services, materials, and facilities that this library has to offer, regardless of content, format, or detail.
