

PATTERSON LIBRARY

GIFTS

The Patterson Library defines a gift as any physical materials and/or legal investment or financial instrument, which is given, bequeathed or endowed to the Patterson Library. Any gift becomes the property of the library.

The library reserves the right to determine whether a gift will be accepted or denied. Once a gift of materials is accepted the library will determine how and when they will be made accessible.

The library also reserves the right to relinquish ownership of any gift as determined by the library, at any time in the future. The library may provide an acknowledgment of any gift, but cannot state its dollar value.

Restricted monetary gifts will be accepted on the condition that the specific use requested is consistent with the goals and objectives of the Library.

Unrestricted monetary gifts will be used at the discretion of the Patterson Library Board of Trustees in accordance with this gift policy and/or the library's material selection policy.

Patterson Library is a 501C3 organization, any gift may be tax deductible to the full extent of the law.
